Sunday 22nd October – *Nigel Goddard*, an audio engineer who previously worked on Rolls Royce jet engines, who has a scientific interest in the *Turin Shroud*. Was this the shroud that wrapped Jesus' body following his crucifixion? Nigel will present the evidence.

Sunday 19th November – Royal Navy Chaplain *The Rev'd Martin Evans* will speak about a year living in a L'Arche Community in London, that shaped his life and ministry. In a world that values winning and coming first, L'Arche Communities are places where people with learning disabilities can discover who they are, not just what they can do.



Sunday 10th December – An evening of *Advent and Christmas* carols, readings and traditions from around the world. Bring something to share from your country and enrich us all.

Sunday 14th January, 2018 – An evening with *Satheesh Paul*, a winner of the prestigious Sandro Boticelli Prize. He will reflect on his art and what inspires his work.



Sunday 18th February, 2018 *Judith Baker* will introduce the writings of the Franciscan priest *Richard Rohr*, founder of the Center for Action and Contemplation and encourage us to go deeper this Lent.
